Subject: The Regulation of International College Student Uniforms beginning 2017

---

To dress appropriately and maintain the honor of Chiang Mai Rajabhat University, the International College has agreed to announce The Regulation of International College Student Uniform beginning 2017. Students must strictly follow the regulations as follows:

**Student uniform for weekday program**

**1. Men's student uniform**

- 1.1 Only white shirt, short or long sleeves (don't flip sleeves), shirttails inside trousers.
- 1.2 Proper black or dark blue trousers. (NO Jeans)
- 1.3 If wearing necktie, please only use the university's necktie with pin.  
(All 1<sup>st</sup> year students must dress with necktie)
- 1.4 University's belt only.
- 1.5 Black leather shoes or black canvas shoes. No slippers.
- 1.6 Short and proper hairstyle. Do not dye your hair, and no beard.

**2. Women's student uniform**

- 2.1 Only white shirt with university button, not too tight, shirttails inside trousers.
- 2.2 Put the university pin above the left chest.
- 2.3 Proper black skirt. (NO kind of trousers or jeans)
- 2.4 University's belt only.
- 2.5 Black leather shoes or white canvas shoes. No slippers.
- 2.6 Proper hairstyle, do not dye your hair.

**3. Any outfit besides the student uniform is allowed as follows:**

Program shirt, College Shirt, Lanna Shirt and Club Shirt. (case by case consideration)

## Student uniform for weekend program

1. Men's student uniform
  - 1.1 Dress appropriately or dress in student uniform.
  - 1.2 No slippers.
2. Women's student uniform
  - 2.1 Dress appropriately or dress in student uniform.
  - 2.2 No slippers.

## Consequences

1. Student attending class, attending exam, or contacting the International College office must follow the Regulation of International College Student Uniform beginning 2017
2. Dean, Head of Department, Head of Program, Lecturers and Advisors, please strictly follow the regulations beginning 1<sup>st</sup> October 2017.
